

### WHAT IS BIRDIES FOR CHARITY?

The Birdies for Charity program was designed as a unique and fresh way for local nonprofits to raise money. Birdies for Charity is a pledge based program based on the number of birdies made by the PGA TOUR professionals Wednesday – Sunday of the Travelers Championship. A birdie is a score of one stroke better than par, and 1,500-2,000 birdies are anticipated to be made by the PGA TOUR professionals. In 2011, 1,839 birdies were made at the Travelers Championship.
